NORTH DAKOTA SPORTS HALL OF FAME

The purpose of the North Dakota Sports Hall of Fame is to honor and recognize those individuals who have played a major role in the growth and development of sports in the State of North Dakota and to further promote sports and sportsmanship to the public of North Dakota by honoring those who have made outstanding contributions in sports.

The North Dakota Sports Hall of Fame has four divisions. They are:

DIVISION I

Honor those individuals who have brought national recognition to North Dakota by their actions on the national level. Their pictures will be displayed in a prominent place in the Civic Center, and they will be honored at a banquet.

DIVISION II

Honors those individuals who have been recognized at the national level in a particular sport or sports activity. (Example: National Coach of the Year, Hobey Baker Award winner, president of a national association, National Athletic Director of the Year, or National Hall of Fame or Honor.) There is a special area designated to honor these people.

DIVISION III

Honors those individuals who have been inducted into their own Sports Association Hall of Fame. Their plaques are now on display at the Civic Center.

DIVISION IV

Honors those individuals who have been inducted into the Sports Hall of Fame of a North Dakota College or University.

Clifton E. Cushman



Cliff Cushman was a man with a vision. He didn't worry about what it could have been; he was more interested in what could be. He was recognized as ND Athlete of the Year in 1960 and as a hurdler in track at the University of Kansas. Cushman won a silver medal in the 1960 Olympic Games in Rome, placing second to another American in the 400-meter hurdles. His dream of capturing the gold medal at the 1964 games was lost when he stumbled over a hurdle at the final US Olympic trial meet in Los Angeles. Everyone felt sorry for the world athlete who came so close, yet so far from reaching a dream.

After that experience, Cushman wrote a letter to the Grand Forks Herald in which he asked the young people in his hometown not to feel sorry for him, but instead to set goals for themselves. His letter, written on an airplane only hours after the unfortunate fall, has always been an inspiration.

After graduating from Kansas in 1961, Cushman became a fighter pilot in the US Air Force. In September 1966, he was listed as missing in action in Vietnam. Cushman was 28 years old at the time. His wife, Carolyn, and 10-month-old son, Colin, could only wait.

Said his wife after being informed of her husband's status: "Somewhere in Vietnam he's running the biggest race of his life. It's like watching a race in which Cliff is running only you can't see the finish tape. He's in excellent physical condition. Cliff also has a very deep faith in God. What better

combination could there be? November 6, 1975, Clifton E. Cushman was officially declared dead. He was posthumously awarded the Silver Star, the Distinguished Flying Cross, and the Purple Heart. Cliff Cushman's timeless inspirational message lives on:

"Don't feel sorry for me. I feel sorry for some of you."

"Last Sunday you may have seen the U.S. Olympic trials on television. If so, you watched me hit the fifth hurdle, fall and lie on the track in an inglorious heap of skinned elbows, bruised hips, torn knees and injured pride, unsuccessful in my attempt to make the Olympic team for the second time."

"In a split second all the many years of training, pain, sweat, blisters and agony of running were simply and irrevocably wiped out. But I tried. I would much rather fail knowing I had put forth an honest effort than never to have tried at all."

"This is not to say that everyone is capable of making the Olympic team. However, each of you is capable of trying to make your own personal 'Olympic team', whether it be the high school football team, the glee club, the honor roll or whatever your goal may be."

"Unless your reach exceeds your grasp, how can you be sure what you can attain? And don't you think there are things better than cigarettes, hot rod cars, school dropouts, excessive makeup, and ducktail grease-cuts?"

"Over 15 years ago I saw a star - first place in the Olympic games. I literally start to run for it. In 1960 I came within three yards of grabbing it; this year I stumbled, fell and watched it recede four more years away."

Certainly, I was very disappointed in falling flat on my face. However, there is nothing I can do about it now but get up, pick the cinders from my wounds and take one more step followed by one more and one more until the steps turn into miles and the miles into success."

"I know I may never make it. The odds are against me, but I have something in my favor - desire and faith."

"Romans 5:3-5 has always had an inspirational meaning to me in this regard: 'We rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us.'"

"At least I am going to try. How about you? Would a little extra effort on your part bring up your grade average? Would you have a better chance to make the football team if you stayed an extra 15 minutes after practice and worked on your blocking?"

"Let me tell you something about yourselves. You are taller and heavier than any past generation in this country. You are spending more money, enjoying more freedom and driving more cars than ever before, yet many of you are unhappy."

"Some of you have never known the satisfaction of doing your best in sports, the joy of excelling in class, the wonderful feeling of completing a job, any job, and looking back on it knowing that you have done your best."

"I dare you to have your hair cut and not wilt under the comments of your so-called friends. I dare you to clean up your language. I dare you to honor your mother and father. I dare you to go to church without having to be compelled to go by your parents."

"I dare you to unselfishly help someone less fortunate than yourself and enjoy the wonderful feeling that goes with it. I dare you to become physically fit. I dare you to read a book that is not required in school."

"I dare you to look up at the stars, not down at the mud and set your sights on one of them that, up to now, you thought was unattainable. There is plenty of room at the top but no room for anyone to sit down." "Who knows? You may be surprised at what you can achieve with sincere effort. So get up, pick the cinders out of your wounds and take one more step. I dare you."

GREG ESLINGER



A Bismarck native, Eslinger attended Bismarck High School, and the University of Minnesota, where he was a four-year starter for the Minnesota Golden Gophers football team from 2002 to 2005.

Eslinger was a three-time first-team All-Big Ten selection (2003, 2004, 2005) and a unanimous All-American in 2005. As a senior in 2005, he was awarded the Outland Trophy, which is given to college football's most outstanding interior lineman in the country, as well as the Dave Rimington Trophy, awarded to college football's top center. He was the first player ever to win both awards in the same season. Minnesota went 32-18, posting winning records in all four years of his college career. He led the Gophers to four consecutive bowl games for the first time in school history, notching a 3-1 record in postseason play and ranking No. 17 in the final Coaches Poll after the 2003 season with a victory against Oregon in the Sun Bowl.

During his tenure, the Gophers set multiple single-season offensive records, including rushing attempts (683), rushing yards (3,759), rushing yards per game (289.2), rushing touchdowns (46), total season yards (6,430), total yards per game (494.8), total season points (503), average points per game (38.7), season touchdowns (66) and first downs (326).

A two-time Second Team CSC Academic All-American and a three-time Academic All-Big Ten pick, Eslinger earned an NFF National Scholar-Athlete Award as a 2005 NFF William V. Campbell Trophy Finalist, and he received the 2006 Big Ten Medal of Honor for his combined efforts on the field and in the classroom. He was inducted into the M Club Hall of Fame in 2016.

Eslinger is one of just two MN Gophers to ever earn First Team All-Big Ten honors three times and started all 50 games of his college career. A two-year team captain, Eslinger anchored an offensive unit that twice led the Big Ten in rushing with 256.8 yards per game in 2004 and 273.1 yards per game in 2005. He opened the lanes for four consecutive 1,000-yard Gopher running backs, including Laurence Maroney who shared team Co-MVP honors with Eslinger in 2005 and led the Big Ten with 1,464 yards. He was named a *Sporting News* Freshman All American (2002), Rimington Trophy finalist (2004), FWAA All American (2004), third team Big Ten Offensive Lineman of the Year (2005), and a Lombardi Award semifinalist (2005). Eslinger was inducted into the 2025 class of the College Football Hall of Fame on January 15, 2025.

The Denver Broncos chose Eslinger in the sixth round (198th overall pick) of the 2006 NFL draft, where he spent his first year on the IR. Assigned to the Cologne Centurions of the NFL Europa for 2007, he started at center and earned All-NFL Europa honors. The Broncos moved Eslinger to the practice squad at the beginning of 2007. On November 13, 2007, the Cleveland Browns picked him off the Bronco practice squad. On December 12, 2007, he was released from the Cleveland Browns. On December 20, 2007, he was signed to the Houston Texans practice squad. Eslinger was re-signed to the Bronco practice squad in the 2008 season.

After playing in the NFL, Eslinger entered the business world as an orthopedic sales consultant with DePuy Synthes Companies in Minnesota. He participates in marathons and triathlons, has coached youth football and hockey, and has also volunteered with the Special Olympics and as a motivational speaker to elementary and junior high school students.

RANDY HEDBERG



Longtime college head coach, North Dakota native and former NFL quarterback Randy Hedberg has been North Dakota State University's quarterbacks coach since 2014. Elevated to associate head coach and passing game coordinator in 2019, he has been part of seven Missouri Valley Football Conference championships and six NCAA Division I FCS national championships at NDSU.

Hedberg, who was named the 2020-21 FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association, has mentored three NFL draft picks in eight seasons at North Dakota State, including two quarterbacks selected in the top three overall at the NFL Draft. He has been part of Bison teams that have produced seven of the top eight seasons of total offense in NDSU history including a school-record 7,076 yards in 2018 and 7,512 yards in 2019.

Redshirt freshman Trey Lance in 2019 won the Stats Perform Walter Payton Award and Jerry Rice Award as the top offensive player and top freshman player in the Football Championship Subdivision. Lance accounted for 42 total touchdowns, led the nation in passing efficiency (180.6), and set an NCAA all-divisions record for most passing attempts in a season without an interception (287) before being selected No. 3 overall by the San Francisco 49ers in the 2021 NFL Draft.

Hedberg previously groomed FCS all-time winningest quarterback Easton Stick, who led the Bison to the national championship game with eight wins as a freshman in 2015 and finished 49-3 in his career with two national title victories as the starter. Stick set NDSU career records for passing yards (8,693), passing touchdowns (88), total offense (11,216) and total touchdowns (129) before being selected in the fifth round of the 2019 NFL Draft by the Los Angeles Chargers.

Hedberg tutored eventual No. 2 overall pick Carson Wentz to a record-setting season as a first-year starter in 2014. The Bison junior passed for a school-record 3,111 yards while also setting school marks for passing attempts and completions. Wentz was 20-3 as the Bison starter and led NDSU to victories in the 2014 and 2015 national championship games before starting all 16 games as a rookie in 2016 with the Philadelphia Eagles.

No stranger to the Bison program, Hedberg was the head coach for nine seasons at North Central Conference rival St. Cloud State and came to NDSU after six seasons as the quarterbacks coach and co-offensive coordinator at Southern Illinois.

He was the head coach at St. Cloud State from 1999-07 and at Minot State for eight seasons from 1982-89 compiling a 92-75-2 mark overall. Hedberg was the offensive coordinator at Central Missouri (1990-95) and North Dakota (1996-98) in between head coaching jobs.

An eighth-round draft pick of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 1977, Hedberg started four regular-season games including his first game as a rookie in 1977. He appeared in seven games with the Bucs that year before spending time with the Oakland Raiders in 1979 and the Green Bay Packers in 1980.

A native of Parshall, ND, he was named one of North Dakota's 50 greatest sports figures of the 20th century, checking in at No. 31 on the list published by Sports Illustrated. He passed for a school-record 5,737 yards and 49 touchdowns at Minot State, where he played football, basketball, baseball and threw the javelin. He was inducted into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1985, and the football field in Parshall was named in his honor at a dedication ceremony in 2020.

Hedberg graduated from Minot State in 1977 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and a minor in mathematics. He earned a Master of Education in health, physical education and recreation from North Dakota in 1987.

Among his other accomplishments are his family, His wife Chery Hysjulien, and children, Jennifer, Kate, Christopher and Maddie.

TIMOTHY OLSON



A native of Bismarck and proud graduate of St. Mary's Central High School, Tim Olson's legacy as one of North Dakota's most accomplished athletes spans multiple sports and levels—from state championships to the Major Leagues.

At St. Mary's, Tim was a standout three-sport athlete. In baseball, he was a three-year starting shortstop, leading the Saints to two State Championships and a State Runner-Up finish, while earning All-State honors and multiple team awards.

In football, Tim was a three-year letterwinner and a dynamic force on both sides of the ball. He earned All-State honors his senior year and played a key role in the Saints' state championship and runner up during his high school career.

On the basketball court, Tim earned two varsity letters and was named to the All-Region Team as a senior, showcasing his athleticism and leadership across all seasons.

Tim's exceptional baseball career took off early, beginning his American Legion Baseball journey at 14 with the Bismarck Royals. At 15, he joined the Bismarck Scarlets, and by 16, he was anchoring the infield for the Bismarck Governors. In 1997, Tim helped the Governors win the North Dakota State American Legion Championship, earning Outstanding Player of the Tournament honors. Over five years of Legion play, Tim posted extraordinary career numbers: 896 at-bats, 312 hits, 290 runs, 57 doubles, 11 triples, 31 home runs, 173 RBIs, 92 stolen bases, and a .348 career batting average. His 18-year-old season was particularly remarkable: 101 hits, 16 home runs, 66 RBIs, 32 stolen bases, and a .426 batting average. As a pitcher, he went 17-5 with 166 strikeouts.

Following Legion Regionals, Tim attended Hutchinson Community College in Kansas under Missouri Sports Hall of Fame, Coach John Burgi. At Hutch, he was not only an Academic All-American, but also a dominant offensive force—setting school records with 73 RBIs and a .460 batting average. After his freshman year, he was drafted by the Tampa Bay Devil Rays (36th round, 1998 MLB Draft) but chose to continue his academic and athletic career.

Tim transferred to the University of Florida, playing under the College Baseball Hall of Fame, Coach Andy Lopez for the Gators. In his junior year, he delivered one of the most outstanding seasons in school history, hitting .394 with 15 home runs and 75 RBIs, and setting a school record with a 29-game hitting streak. His list of accolades includes Top Offensive Player & Coach Fuller Award for timely hitting, All-SEC First Team (Regular Season & Tournament), Baseball Weekly, ABCA/Rawlings, Baseball America, and Collegiate Baseball All-American honors, Rotary Smith and Golden Spikes Award Nominee, ABCA/Rawlings All-South Region First Team, and NCAA Waco Regional Most Outstanding Player.

Following his junior year, Tim was drafted in the 7th round of the 2000 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks. He bypassed rookie ball and advanced quickly through the minor leagues, making his Major League debut on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball in 2004 against the Los Angeles Dodgers at Dodger Stadium.

Tim continued his professional career playing winter ball in Mexico for the Mazatlán Venados, winning both the Mexican Pacific League Championship and the Caribbean World Series. He later played in the Colorado Rockies, Texas Rangers, and Toronto Blue Jays organizations before finishing his career back with the Rockies.

Tim credits much of his development to the influence of Coach Gene Severson, his coach during four of his five Legion seasons, and the strength of the American Legion Baseball program.

Today, Tim lives in Colorado with his wife Stephanie and their three children. He has built a successful career in employee benefits consulting and remains active in coaching youth sports and mentoring the next generation of athletes.

From championship seasons at St. Mary's to his debut under the bright lights of Dodger Stadium, Tim Olson's journey is a testament to discipline, athletic excellence, and the supportive community that helped raise him.

SHERI KLEINSASSER STOCKMOE



A native of Carrington, N.D., Sheri Kleinsasser Stockmoe was a multi-sport athlete for the Cardinals. On the basketball court, the 1991 graduate helped lead her team to two back-to-back runner-up finishes in the state Class B tournament and was named to the All-State First Team in her senior season. She was also a Class B state champion in track claiming titles in the Shot Put and Discus her final season.

Sheri continued her athletic career at the University of North Dakota, becoming one of the best women's basketball players ever to play at UND. She was a four-time All-North Central Conference selection, two-time All-American (1994 and 1995), the 1992 NCC Freshman of the Year, 1995 NCC Most Valuable Player and the 1995 Rawlings/WBCA Division II Player of the Year.

During her four years at UND, the Sioux posted an overall record of 96-19 (.835) and a conference record of 62-10 (.861). The Sioux won the conference titles in Sheri's sophomore and junior seasons, including a perfect 18-0 NCC record in 1993-94, the first time in school history that UND was undefeated in conference play in a single season.

UND advanced to the NCAA Division II tournament all four years she played and made it to the national quarterfinals her freshman season.

At the time she finished her career, Sheri was UND's and the NCC's all-time leading scorer. Today she currently ranks in UND's top 10 career list for points (1,941), field goals made (770), field goals attempted (1,343), field goal percentage (.573), blocked shots (175), free throws made (401), and free throws attempted (539). She also holds the school's record for best field goal percentage in a single game (1.000 on 10-of-10 shooting in a 92-71 win over South Dakota on March 4, 1995).

The 6'2" center averaged 17 points and 6.3 rebounds per game in her career and scored 30 or more points in a game five times. She earned a bachelor's degree in athletic training ('97) and a master's in kinesiology ('99) from UND.

Sheri is currently the Marketing Director at Bank Forward. She resides in Fargo, N.D.

Among Sheri's other accomplishments are her family; husband Stuart and daughters Seely and Shya.
